Library Improvement and Equipment Trust

A gift to the Clarion Public Library's trust means the difference between a good library and a great library! With support from grants and public donations, this fund is for technology and equipment improvements intended to enrich library programming and services for children, teens, and adults.

The purpose of the trust is to enhance library programming and services beyond what the library's normal operating budget can allow. LIET funds are not intended to be used on capital improvement projects / repairs to the library's physical facility; funds do not replace or supplant city and/or county funding.

From the Clarion City / Library Ordinance Chapter 22.05 (10) Powers & Duties of the Library Board *"...To accept gifts of real property, personal property, or mixed property, and devises and bequests, including trust funds; to take title to said property in the name of the Library; to execute deeds and bill of sale for the conveyance of said property; and to expend the funds received by them from such gifts for the improvement of the Library..."*
