

Sex Offender Policy
(Ref :Iowa Code 692A)

Registered sex offenders (of victims who were minors) cannot loiter within 300 feet of the real property boundary of the library and are not allowed on the library property. The Clarion Public Library Director will not give written or any other form of permission to any registered sex offender convicted of sex offenses against minors to be present on library property.

Registered sex offenders may be eligible to use library services (per residency requirements). In those cases, the offender may register for a card via telephone or email or by utilizing a designee to complete the process on their behalf. The offender must utilize a designee to check items out on their behalf for their use. Items checked out with the offender's card remains the registered sex offender's responsibility. Library resources and services offered on-line are available to the registered sex offender to use as any other patron would.

Violations of this policy must be reported to law enforcement. Violators will lose all library privileges.
